There were 6 new registrations for September, 2020. There were 1 dog, 3 cats, and 2 rabbits belonging to 3 new and 1 existing pet parents. The total number of pet parents listed is 173 with 392 separate pets, although the information that I have does not include many of the earlier registrations. Starfleet Sciences has a [web site](#) which includes a Chief Science Officer Handbook; in the past month, the number of hits to the web page increased 30 to 5428. Starfleet Sciences also has a listserv and Facebook page; the Facebook page has **2592** lifetime total likes and **680** daily total impressions for August. A [Pinterest](#) board of science-related events by region is available. A Stellar Cartography department, with Capt. Michael Krogh (mkrogh@mail.com) at its head, has a goal to promote amateur astronomy through information, advice and communication. Stellar Cartography's [Facebook](#) page is. Starfleet Sciences Director Richard Heim and wife are safe and healthy, continuing to shelter at home, to escape the novel corona virus COVID-19, and teleworking. Starfleet Sciences receives reports from the regional science officers or liaisons in seven regions (1, 7, 8, 9, 11, 13, and 15). Region One Sciences (also led by Adm. Heim) was active with six ships reporting in August, and Region 7's Comm. Held summarized many new developments in the field of astronomy and space exploration reported by the USS Sovereign. Comm. Held's summary included reports on: revisions to age of Moon; Venus may have active volcanoes now; new study on origin of Earth's plate tectonics; Earth's magnetic field behavior; ancient Mars climatology and hydrology; Mars's interior layers studied; Jupiter's huge moon Ganymede may have the largest impact scar in the solar system; and asteroid Ceres may be an ocean world. August posts to the Starfleet Sciences Facebook page covered such topics as: 100 million year old microbes from beneath the sea still alive; new solar technologies; key brain region recycled as humans developed the ability to read; awareness of our biases is essential to good science; how US Vice Presidents when from irrelevant to influential; NASA's TESS planet-hunting telescope; Moon to Mars ice and prospecting challenge; and the robot scientists are coming, as well as Science Shows on TV This Week. The most popular post was Scientists pull living microbes, possibly 100 million years old, from beneath the sea, viewed by 75 people.

Social Media Services still reports that there are still people not following the guidelines set to admit members to our Facebook, mailing lists and other social media outlets we oversee.

If you have such STARFLEET publications, please contact Lieutenant Feldman at the email address given in the last paragraph. It will be very much appreciated!

CES OFFICE

Well from the main office, have been trying to crunch numbers for the Academy and make pushes.

I gave my staff different timelines to complete the SFDPP courses. I have some that are pushing to the wire. The staff has worked hard to get SFDPP completed within the timeframe given. After the 20th of September the timeframe for SFDPP is out for my staff. I will see who has followed directives on it.

I have been pushing harder and harder for the courses to be reviewed and updated. I have also asked that they be sent to be archived. We are trying to have updated info in the manuals and courses for the members of STARFLEET, The International Star Trek Fan Association, Inc.

Now I mentioned crunching numbers.

- I have been looking at how many of SFDPP has been taken. We have had 1084 of the SFDPP taken. This breaks down to 527 people that has completed both SFDPP 101 and SFDPP 102. You need to have both completed by the deadline that the AB has put in place.
- SFA has 18 institutes with 129 colleges. SFA offers 3,437 courses. To date, the directors and assistant directors has completed about 50% of the colleges in revisions. I admit that this may not look like much but remember there are over 3,000 courses to be reviewed. And I only count based on colleges not the number of courses. They are still trekking forward to accomplish having these done by the end of the year.
- SFMCA has 5 colleges with 20 schools in total. They have 139 courses in total. All the courses are put into Moodle as PDFs. You can request the courses in Moodle and email your answers to the Directors.
- The Course Catalog is published at least monthly. The catalog is placed in Moodle as well as on the STARFLEET Members Only Facebook page, STARFLEET Business Only Facebook page, and our own Educational Services Facebook page. We place them in these locations as we try to limit the exposure of information to maintain Data Privacy Policies. If it is shared, please make sure you follow the Privacy Policies.

I want to thank Jill Rayburn, Cher Schleigh, and Carol Thompson for helping to compile these numbers and for the work they are doing to make sure the SFDPP is counted in a timely manner. I want to thank the rest of my staff as well as the staff of SFA on making sure that all work from the students does not get missed during the time that they had to complete their SFDPP and on making sure their duties are proceeding as scheduled.

SFA NEWS

Once again, the numbers have increased. The approximate number of students for August was just over 200, which is an increase of more than 50. The approximate number of individual courses taken was just over 2,200, which is an increase of more than 400. (These figures do not count SFDPP.) I attribute this to the reopening of a number of popular colleges, and also to people who come to Moodle to take SFDPP, and find other things that are of interest.

Approximately 550 members have taken both of the SFDPP courses. We are verifying completions when asked for by appropriate staff members. I'm sure we will have another increase in exams as the deadline approaches.

As previously reported, the revision/update project is proceeding, with several more colleges completed this month. Also, work continues to get more of courses automated in Moodle, and we are also testing a file submission system for those courses that may not work well in the automated system. Several of our colleges have new courses in development, and we even have some new colleges being developed. It is important to us to provide a fun and informative experience for all of our students.

I want to give kudos to Lauren White in HR. She is very easy to work with regarding our openings, and works very hard for us and for Fleet. She is helpful, polite, and prompt. I will be posting a new set of openings with her very soon. We have gotten a few more new staff members again this month, but unfortunately, we may be losing a few who have not taken their SFDPP, or who are not performing the duties required of their jobs.
